To register, the student must submit a written plan of study approved by the faculty instructor EEB faculty in charge. Students are encouraged to apply during the term preceding the tutorial. Proposals must be submitted no later than the first day of the second week of the term in which the student enrolls in the tutorial. The final paper is due in the hands of the EEB faculty in charge by the last day of reading period in the term of enrollment. In special cases, with the approval of the director of undergraduate studies, this course may be elected for more than one term. Please attach this form to your proposal and return to the DUS Office. Underclassmen will receive one credit and a grade of P/F.</p>
